Degree Requirements

The following requirements are in addition to, or further elaborate upon, those requirements outlined in The Graduate School Policy Guide (https://catalogs.northwestern.edu/tgs/academic-policies-procedures/).

Master's

The Department of Sociology does not offer a terminal MA degree. Sociology PhD students may apply for a master's degree en route to their PhD. The Department of Sociology requires that all departmental required courses be completed, and second year paper be approved, as part of these 9 graded courses.

Total Units Required: 20 Units (plus 1 quarter of SOCIOL 480-0 Introduction to the Discipline and 1 quarter of SOCIOL 519-0 Responsible Conduct of Research Training)

Other PhD Degree Requirements

- Research/Projects: Second-year paper suitable for publication that must be completed by the end of 2nd year (may be used as master's thesis; see Master's above).
- Examinations: Qualifying examination for admission to candidacy is the Special Fields Paper that must be completed at the end of 3rd year.
- · PhD Dissertation: Based on original, independent research
- · Final Evaluations: Defense of dissertation
